Atholl Place threw open its doors last week in the cosmopolitan northern suburb of Atholl in Johannesburg.

For the opening-night party lucky guests were chauffeured from Atholl Square, where Jozi's sleek set meet at Tasha's and shop at fun décor stores like Adam Levin's Imagination. Sandton City, Nelson Mandela Square and Village Walk are all nearby.

ACCOMODATION:

The small, luxury boutique hotel was developed by Sumari Krige, the intrepid owner of La Grange interiors and brains behind Rooms on View, and her husband, Gerhard Krige, a property developer.

French-Belgian architect Pierre Lombart and interior designer Adele van der Merwe have transformed the original 1970s thatched-roof house into a contemporary urban oasis decorated in tones

of white and grey.

Krige has travelled the world collecting pieces for Atholl place, but the ultimate emphasis is on the sort of luxurious comfort with which anyone who has shopped at La Grange will be familiar.

The 10 suites are spacious and have been individually decorated in an effort to create a "home away from home".

Guests enjoy sumptuous breakfasts in the glamorous dining area or in the tranquil gardens. A light lunch and dinner are prepared by the talented chef.
